Crucifixion and Death We pray for all priests who are in their last agony and those who will die today. We pray for those who thirst for the salvation of souls. We pray that the crucifixion of their wills may accomplish God's designs for the salvation of the whole world.

We pray that He will remove the veil from His Divinity in the Holy Eucharist so that all will come to believe in His Eucharistic Presence and will love and adore Him.

*The Institution of the Holy Eucharist: We thank God for the greatest of His gifts: Himself in the Holy Eucharist. We pray for all to receive Him with great love and be united with Him in mind and heart.
